

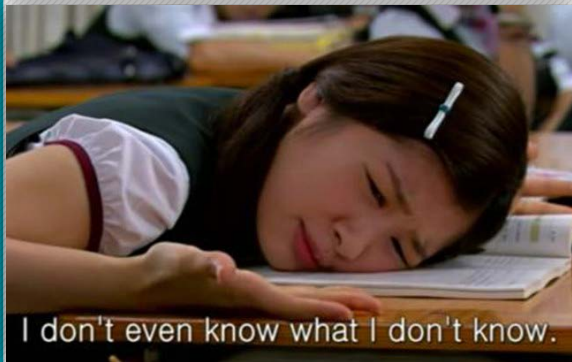

# WHAT IS THE CENSUS?

The Census is a survey, established by the US Constitution, that occurs every 10 years to count every person in the United States, no matter age, residence status, or location.

# WHAT'S THE POINT?

- **Determines the number of representatives in Congress for North Carolina**
- **Allocates federal funds in North Carolina**
- **Establishes the boundaries for voting and school districts**
- **Provides information needed to improve schools, roads, health care, emergency response and other services in your community.**

# MAKE NC COUNT!!!

The Census is your chance to make sure your community counts. Participating in the Census will help make sure your community gets:

- Fair representation in Congress
- Financial resources for health, schools, transportation, and more
- Information leaders need to help your community plan for the future.
