Additional Vehicle Information: (physical inspection and/or documents required)

Registered vehicle appeals and supporting documentation must be postmarked within 30 days of the date the taxes are due on the vehicle. (G.S. 105-330.2)

Motor vehicles are valued at average market value for property tax purposes. A motor vehicle offered for sale by a dealer to the consumer represents the best example of market value. Classified motor vehicles are not valued at wholesale, blue book or private party asking price for property tax purposes. (G.S. 105-283)

Value adjustments may be warranted if the owner can document high mileage, significant body damage or frame damage, excessively worn interior or other damage that may significantly reduce the value. Normal wear and tear will not be considered.

Documentation that may be considered for a vehicle value appeal:

- Bill of Sale documenting the sticker price from the dealer.
- Pictures of the vehicle documenting its condition.
- Repair estimates for a vehicle that has significant damage.
- Odometer reading.

Documentation that will not be considered for a vehicle value appeal:

- Wholesale or blue book values from any internet website, magazine or catalog.
- A trade in or wholesale value appraisal from a dealer.
- Written offers from a dealer to purchase your vehicle.
- A Bill of Sale from a private owner.

The taxpayer must pay the tax in full when due, regardless of a pending appeal, subject to full or partial refund if the appeal is decided in the owner's favor.
