ADOPTION PROCESS

Adoptions are first come, first serve. We do not place reservations on animals.

Once the adoption process starts, it typically lasts 30 to 45 minutes.

Because we strive to make the best possible match between you and your new companion, you will go through a brief interview with one of our adoption counselors to ensure the best possible fit.

After the interview, you will have a chance to meet the animal in our Meet and Greet rooms. We recommend that the animal meet the entire family. (Including your current dogs!)

Arrangements may have to be made for you to bring in your current animal to introduce it to the new animal.

After the meet and greet is done, we will process your adoption and you can take your new family member home!

If the animal is unaltered and scheduled for surgery, they will be placed with you under our Foster to Adopt program. The adoption will be finalized once the animal has been altered.

We do reserve the right to deny adoptions if the placement may pose a risk to you or the animal.
