Pursuant to New York State Executive Law, Article 2-B, and the authority in me vested, I had, heretofore declared and renewed a local State of Emergency within the territorial limits of the County of Oswego regarding the COVID-19 pandemic and to mobilize the county's response and resources regarding same.

I no longer find and determine these conditions rise to the level of a threat to the public health and safety of the citizens of Oswego County when the state of emergency was first declared. While COVID-19 remains a concern, I find increased vaccinations and lower positivity rates within the Oswego County no longer require a State of Emergency declaration.

NOW, THEREFORE, as Chief Executive of Oswego County, I, JAMES WEATHERUP, do hereby **RESCIND AND REPEAL** the State of Emergency proclamation and any and all emergency orders issued by me under New York State Executive Law §24 **FORTHWITH** within the territorial limits of the County of Oswego.
