GARBAGE CONTAINER REGULATIONS

These regulations are designed to prevent odor and littering problems, damage to the truck's hydraulic system, and efficient use of the truck's auto-rail system.

1. Garbage containers are for the use of household garbage only. Businesses in residential areas should make arrangements for commercial pickup.
 2. Bag food waste, paper, or small items in plastic bags before placing in container.
 3. Contain animal waste in plastic bags before placing in container. Fish cleanings should be taken to the designated container at Scenic Sports on East Broadway.
 4. Flatten boxes before placing in container.
 5. **Do not** put grass clippings, leaves, garden foliage, tree trimmings, furniture, carpet, bulky or heavy items, concrete blocks, dirt, wire, or construction and demolition material into container.
 6. **Do not** put used oil in container. The City provides a disposal site for used oil on the west side of the Public Works Maintenance Shop at 809 5th Street East.
 7. Dried out paint can be disposed with normal trash.
 8. Keep container lid closed and opening facing alley! **Do not** turn or block container. **Do not** put anything on top of container.

BOX TRUCK REGULATIONS

Anything larger than 4 feet will not fit in the truck's hopper and will not be taken. Any items that cannot be handled by 1 person will not be taken.

1. The regular box truck schedule runs from May through September, Monday through Thursday, 7:30-4:00. It also runs for a short period after Christmas. Whenever the box truck runs in April or after October, it is on an irregular schedule.
2. All box truck items are to be placed in the alley next to the property where the items are coming from, and at least 3 feet from any adjacent container. Do not place by your neighbor's property because that is where the container is located.
3. All grass clippings and garden foliage must either be bagged or boxed.
4. All tree trimmings are to be less than 3 inches in diameter, cut into 4-foot lengths, bundled, and tied. Tree and compost debris can be taken free of charge to the landfill. Landfill summer hours are 7:30-4:45 Monday-Friday and 8:00-1:45 Saturdays.
5. Not accepted: Rolls of carpet--only small quantities of cut up carpet will be taken. Carpet gets heavy if soaked and boxes that are soggy will fall apart.
6. Not accepted: Lead acid batteries--take these to a local scrap yard business.
